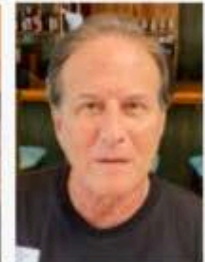

- Sept 27-29 ... Bahama House Daytona weekend

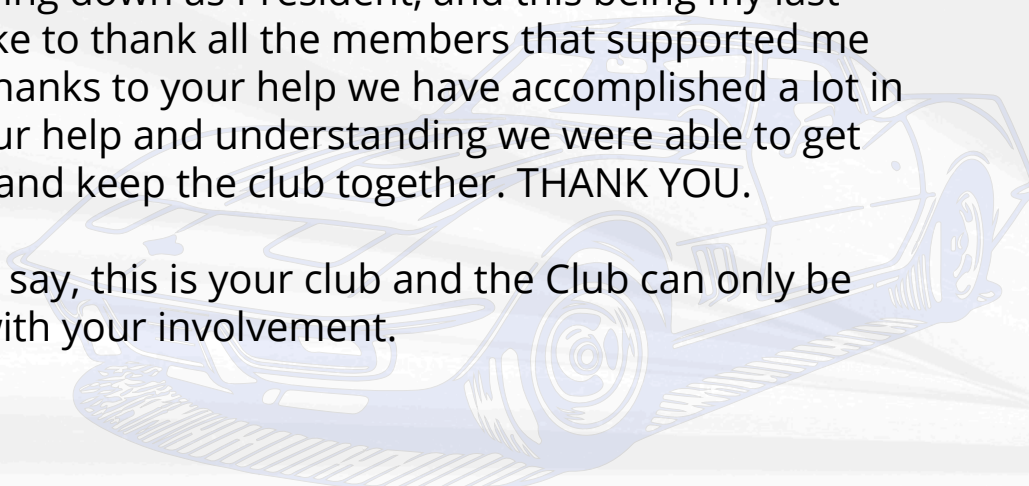
Please visit our website or read our newsletter pertaining to all our upcoming events.

Karl will be dearly missed and my deepest condolences and prayers to Kathy and their family.

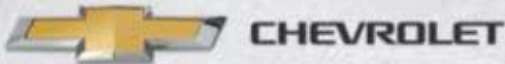
