The business originally opened on December 7, 1941 (Pearl Harbor) as a gas station, small motel and restaurant. It was called the Seldom Inn because the owner was seldom in. It was sold to a couple from Michigan, the McCarthy's, in 1952. The husband and wife ran the location until 1988 when Mr. McCarthy was killed in a hunting accident. Their son Harry came back to help his mother, who is 92 and still works in the dining room, with the daily business. He brought a new menu and attitude to the restaurant to the delight of the locals in Hobe Sound. Thus the name "The Natives".

The restaurant features great food, an attentive staff and many funny signs hanging on the walls. This would be a great place for another run in the future. Try and join us.

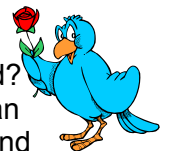
